<u>CIERA</u> (Centre Interdisciplinaire d'Etudes et de Recherches sur l'Allemagne; Interdisciplinary Research Centre for German Studies): research mobility grant for research in German-speaking countries (Germany, Austria and Switzerland); maximum duration: 4 months, renewable once.

Bourses pour étudiants arabisants et étudiants



<u>chercheurs sur le monde arabe de Ministère de l'enseignement supérieur et de la recherché</u> (Ministry of Higher Education Language learning and research grants); destination: Egypt (Cairo), Tunisia (Tunis), Bayreuth (Lebanon); Duration: 9 month; amount: €450/month+ tuition fees+ health insurance.

IFUW International fellowships (International Federation of University Women): research grants for women scholars for all countries; duration: 8-12 months. Next call for grants: 2014. IFUW fellowships and grants are open only to women graduates who are members of IFUW's national federations and associations and to IFUW Independent Members.

<u>Frontenac</u>: research mobility grant for a jointly supervised thesis (between France and Quebec); destination: Quebec; duration: 3 months- 1 year.

BAnQ (Bibliothèque et Archives Nationales du Québec; Quebec National Library and Archives): research mobility to grant to Quebec National Library and Archives; duration: short stay: 20 to 60 days, long stay 61 to 120 days;], amount: covers part of the accommodation costs and the flight costs; only researchers who do not live and are not permanent residents in Quebec can apply; disciplines: literature, history, library studies, information studies, musicology, philosophy, anthropology, communication studies.

<u>Beryl Henderson memorial grant</u> (Beryl Henderson Foundation and Australian Federation of University Women): research mobility grant; destination: Australia; amount: \$1 500; Australian citizens are not eligible to apply; all disciplines welcome but priority given to research projects investigating women's welfare.

JAUW International fellowship (Japanese Association of University Women); research mobility grant; destination: Japan; duration: 5-6 months; Amount: ¥700,000 to 1, 000, 000 depending on the length of the trip; pre-requisites: be a woman enrolled at a Japanese university, priority given to members of the International Federation of University Women; all disciplines welcome.

International Youth Culture and Study Tour to the Republic of China (Taiwan): group study trip; duration: 12 days in July or August; amount: covers accommodation, transport and local charges; pre-requisites: be a doctoral student from one of the countries in Europe, Africa or Latin America and have a reference letter from the Embassy of Taiwan or its representative bureau.

DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service); long-term research trip; destination: Germany; duration: 1- 10 months (up to 18 in the case of a joint supervision thesis); pre-requisites: be a French citizen or be enrolled in a French university for more than a year; good knowledge of German (assessed by an official test at the Goethe-Institute); amount: €1000/month.

IKY State Scholarships Foundation: Scholarships for foreigners; 1 year long research stay in Greece; duration: 1 year during the PhD programme; destination: Greece; all disciplines welcome; prerequisites: good knowledge of English or French and Greek, pre-established contact with a Greek academic; be a citizen of one of the EU member states or Iceland, Norway, Switzerland, USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, or Japan. Amount: €500/month+ €600 insertion grant+ tuition fees.

<u>YGGDRASIL</u> (Norwegian Research Council); research mobility grants; duration: 1-10 months; destination: Norway; all disciplines welcome; amount: kr12, 000/month + kr10, 000 installation grant; pre-requisites: have a letter of invitation.

Ecole française de Rome (French School at Rome); research grants; duration: 1-2 months; destination: Rome; disciplines: archaeology, social sciences; amount: €900.month+ accommodation at the Navone residence in Rome; pre-requisites: have a MA diploma from a French university; be enrolled in a doctoral programme at a French University or in a joint supervision programme (one of the institutions must be French).

<u>CEFC</u> (Centre d'Etudes Françaises sur la Chine Contemporaine; Contemporary China French Research Centre): PhD scholarships; duration: 9 months (non-renewable); destination: China, Hong Kong, Taiwan; Amount: €1625/month+ insurance; pre-requisites: be enrolled in a doctoral programme at a French university or one of the partner countries of CEFC, be a citizen of one of the EU member states.

Toshiba International Foundation Fellowship: research mobility grant; duration: 3 months; destination: Japan; disciplines: Japanese studies; amount: €7000; pre-requisites: minimum 4 years of higher education completed in Europe.

Figura (Centre de recherche sur le texte et l'imaginaire; Centre of Research on Text and the Imaginary) research stay grant at the Centre Figura de l'université du Québec à Montréal; destination: Montreal; duration: 2 months minimum; disciplines: literature, cinema, visual arts, history of art, translation studies, library studies, sociology, research projects corresponding to the research activity of the Centre; amount: \$4 000.

<u>EFEO</u> (Ecole française d'Extrême-orient French School in the Far East): fieldwork scholarships; destinations: Cambodia, South Korea, India, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Malasia, Myamar, China, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam; duration: 1-6 months; Amount: between €700-1360 depending on the country; disciplines: Oriental Studies; pre-requisites: knowledge of the language(s) of the country; contractual students are not eligible to apply.

<u>Center for Chinese Studies:</u> grant program; research stay at the Center for Chinese Studies, National Central Library; destination: Taiwan, Taipei; duration: 3-12 months; amount: monthly stipend (variable amount), return flight tickets, use of resources; disciplines: Chinese studies.

Su Tian-shui postgraduate scholarship: research grant; destination: Taiwan, the Tainan region; duration: no requirements; disciplines: projects focuses on the Tainan region; amount: NT\$ 101,000 (approx. €2200).

<u>MOE</u>- The Talent Civilization Project of Taiwanese Literature, History and Art in Globalization; research grant; destination: Taiwan; duration: 6 -12 months; amount: up to NT\$ 500, 000 NTD (approx. €11, 000); disciplines: Taiwanese literature, history and art; pre-requisites: Taiwanese citizens are not eligible to apply.

Institut für Europäische Geschichte Mainz (Institute for European History in Mainz); research fellowship programme; destination: Mainz, Institut für Europäische Geschichte; duration: 6-12 months; amount: €1200; disciplines: Intellectual history, history of religion and philosophy in Europe (1450-1950); pre-requisites: knowledge of German; be at least 3 years into the PhD programme at the time of applying.

<u>CRFJ</u> (Centre de Recherche Français à Jérusalem, French Research Centre in Jerusalem): doctoral and post-doc research mobility grant; destination: Israel, Jerusalem, duration: 3-9 months; amount: €1220/month; return travel costs, medical insurance; disciplines: archaeology; Intellectual, religious and historical traditions of the Middle East; contemporary Israeli studies; pre-requisites: be a citizen of one of the UE member states.

Prix Michel Seurat (ISHS): field work prize; destination: Syria, Jordan; duration: unspecified; amount €20, 000; pre-requisites: knowledge of the language of the country; be under 35 years old; be a citizen of one of the EU member states or one of the countries in Maghreb or the Middle East; all disciplines welcome.

IFHA (Institut français d'histoire en Allemagne, French Historical Institute in Germany): long-term research stay grant which involves participation in the activities of the French Historical Institute in Germany; destination: Frankfurt am Main, Germany; duration: 1 year; Amount: €1400/ month + return travel costs; disciplines: ancient history, medieval, modern and contemporary German history, historiography.

<u>SAES-AFEA</u> (Société des Anglicistes de l'Enseignement Supérieur-Association Française d'Études Américaines; Association of Higher Education English Teachers- French Association for American Studies): thesis mobility grant; destination: U.S., Canada, the Caribbean, Ireland, U.K., the Countries of the Commonwealth; duration: unspecified; disciplines: projects focused on displacement; pre-requisites: First Class/Distinction MA dissertation; be enrolled in a doctoral programme; be a member of SAES or AFEA or work under the supervision of a member of one of the two bodies. <u>IFAS</u> (Institut français d'Afrique du Sud; French Institute of Southern Africa): research mobility grant; destination: countries in Southern Africa; duration: unspecified; amount: as required; disciplines: projects linked to Southern Africa; pre-requisites: French or EU citizenship.

<u>Casa de Velasquez</u>: research mobility grants; destination: Spain; duration: 1 month; discipline: Archaeology; History: the project must be related to the research strand of the Ecole des hautes études hispniques et ibériques; pre-requisites: be less than 40 years old.

EFA (Ecole française d'Athènes; French School at Athens): research mobility or fieldwork grant; destination: Greece, Athens or one of the archaeological sites of l'Ecole française d'Athènes; duration: 1-2 months; amount: €710 then €310/month; €960 then €560/month for students without income; disciplines: projects related to the research strands of l'Ecole française d'Athènes; prehistory, history, archaeology.

IFAO (Institut français d'archéologie orientale; French Institute of Oriental Archeology): doctoral and post-doctoral research mobility grants; destination: Egypt; duration: at least 1 month; disciplines: cultures and civilizations of Egypt; amount €1000/month; pre-requisites: EU citizenship.

IRASEC (Institut de recherche sur l'Asie du Sud-Est; South-East Asia Research Institute): fieldwork grant; destination: South East Asia; duration: 6 months; disciplines: political science, anthropology/ethnology, economics, geography, contemporary history, sociology, international relations; amount: €830/month+ 1 return travel; pre-requisites: be enrolled in one of the French doctoral schools.

<u>Fondation d'études de la Chambre des députés de Berlin</u> (German Parliament Study Foundation): pre-doctoral research mobility grants; destination: Berlin, Germany; duration: 12 months; disciplines: projects focusing on Berlin, Germany and requiring access to Berlin archives; amount: €770/month; pre-requisites: be a citizen of UK, France, USA or one of the former Soviet states.

<u>IFHA</u> (Institut français d'histoire en Allemagne; French Historical Institute in Germany): short-term research grants; destination: Germany; duration: 4-6 weeks (over the summer); disciplines: History and civilization of the Germanic countries from the Antiquity to the 20th century.

<u>Finnish Government Scholarship Pool</u>: research mobility grants in one of the Finnish universities; destination: Finland; duration: 3-9 months; amount: €1200/month; pre-requisites: knowledge of the language; have a letter of invitation; all disciplines welcome.

<u>Cimo Fellowships</u>: research stay grants; destination: one of the Finnish universities; duration: 3-12 months; amount: €800-1200; pre-requisites: letter of invitation from a Finnish university.

<u>Paola Sandri research grants</u>; destination: China, Taiwan, Hong Kong; Macao; duration: 1 month minimum; all disciplines welcome; pre-requisites: recipient of other scholarships and contractual students are not eligible to apply; amount €1500.

<u>Centre franco-russe de recherches en Moscou</u> (Franco-Russian Research Centre in Moscow); young researcher's mobility grant; destination: Russia, Belorussia, Ukraine, Moldavia; duration: 1 month minimum; amount: €1300; pre-requisites: be enrolled in a doctoral programme at a French university; disciplines: topic must be linked to one of the countries or to the study of French-Russian relations.

<u>Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation PhD Dissertation fellowship</u>: thesis writing-up grant; Destination: this is not a mobility grant; duration: 1 year; discipline: Chinese studies; amount: up to €12 000; pre-requisites: Taiwanese citizens are not eligible to apply; students in full-time employment are not eligible; be enrolled in a European university and be in the last year of the research.

<u>Kislak fellowships</u>: short-term research visit grant; destination: the Kislak Collection, Library of Congress, Washington D.C.; duration: up to 4 months; disciplines: American studies (archaeology, history, cartography, ethnography, linguistics) focused in particular on Florida, the Caribbean and Mesoamerica; amount: \$4200/month; pre-requisites: the award holder needs to prepare an article for publication within 90 days of finishing the scholarship.

<u>Guest scholarship program</u>: research stay grant; destination: Sweden; duration: 6-12 months; amount: kr12, 000/month + travel grant of kr15, 000; pre-requisites: have a letter of invitation from a Swedish university; applicants must not have lived in Sweden for more than 2 years; check nationality criteria when applying.

<u>Taiwan fellowship</u>: long-term research stay grants; destination: Taiwan; duration: 3-12 months; disciplines: topics related to Taiwan, Chine, Pacific Asia and other aspects of Chinese studies; amount: \$1725/month +return flight+ accident insurance; pre-requisites: have two letters of recommendation, not be a recipient of any other scholarship.

<u>CIERA</u> (Centre Interdisciplinaire d'Etudes et de Recherches sur l'Allemagne; German Studies Interdisciplinary Research Centre): research mobility grants; destination: Germany, Switzerland, Austria. duration: up to six months; disciplines: project needs to be linked to Germany or one of the other German-speaking countries; amount €1200; pre-requisites: the applicant must be enrolled in a French university for at least a year at the time of applying; be able to demonstrate an adequate knowledge of German, not be in receipt of any other scholarship; have a 'host structure' established at one of the German-speaking universities.

Bourses du gouvernement grec (Greek Government Research Grants); long-term research stay grants; destination: one of the research centres or universities in Greece; duration: 10 months; amount: €450/month + €500 installation grant+ travelling costs within the country reimbursed; pre-requisites: have a confirmation of admission into one of the universities or research centres; knowledge of Greek or French or English.

Fondation Onassis: research grants and fellowships; destination: Greece; duration: 5-10 months; disciplines: social sciences, humanities, arts; amount: €850/month+ return travel; pre-requisites: Greek citizens cannot apply.

<u>Bourses du gouvernement mexicain</u> (Mexican Government Research Grants): research stay grant; destination: Mexico; duration: 1-12 months; amount Mex\$9349/month+ insurance (if staying

longer than 3 months) + transport to the city of residence; pre-requisites: very good grades (comparable to 8/10).

<u>Fondation du Japon</u> : research grants (The Japanese Foundation Research Grants); Destination: Japan; duration 4-14 months; disciplines: Japanese studies; amount: ¥310, 000/month+ flight ticket+ insurance+ installation grant; pre-requisites: priority given to scholars conducting research in Japanese and future Japanese studies scholars; applicant must be in the final stages of his/her thesis; the project must foster relations between Japan and the country of origin; the applicant must be from one of the countries Japan has diplomatic ties with and under 35 at the time the application is submitted.

<u>France-Stanford Centre for Interdisciplinary Studies</u>: visiting graduate student researcher fellowship; destination: Stanford University, USA; duration 2-4 months; disciplines: all disciplines welcome but the project should investigate contemporary historical questions significant for France and the US; amount: maximum of \$7000 + \$849/month for a maximum of 3 months; prerequisites: be enrolled in a French university; be accepted for a research fellowship by a Stanford scholar; admission to Stanford does not depend on the grant; the application process is parallel and should be made to Stanford's Graduate Admissions Office.

<u>REFEB</u> (Réseau français d'études brésiliennes; French Network of Brazilian Studies): Master's, Doctoral and Post-Doc research mobility grants; disciplines: topics requiring fieldwork in Brazil; duration: 3 to 6 months; amount: €900/month.
