What TO DO and what NOT TO DO



## TO DO

- 1. DO respect the supervisor and establish a good personal relationship with him/her, because the supervisors usually have the power to give you more funding and work opportunities.
- 2. DO try to publish as many papers as possible, the Chinese academic culture value the number very much, but DO NOT multi-submit papers at different publications. Usually you need to pay a fee for the publisher to publish your paper.

## NOT TO DO

- 1. DO NOT openly criticise of the Communist Party and the government, even though you are in an academic area.
- 2. DO NOT openly talk about some sensitive topics in China, for example, the Tian'anmen indident or the Dalai Lama.
- 3. DO NOT copy, plagiarize, misappropriate or tamper with others' academic achievements.
- 4. DO NOT fake or exaggerate academic experience.
